To be considered for a position you must be eligible for the Young Canada Works or Canada Summer Jobs Program:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and be legally entitled to work in Canada
- The successful candidate will work full-time (35 hrs/week) including weekends for the duration of the summer program, and receive **\$17-19/hour** as compensation. Position is at minimum 12 weeks in duration, from June 7 to August 27. Earlier start date of May 17 possible, dependent on candidate availability.
- Ideal candidates are post-secondary students or graduates with strong interests in the fields of biology, geology, environmental science, museum studies, education, or a related discipline. A valid driver's license and proficiency in both English and French are considered assets.
